June 6, 2018

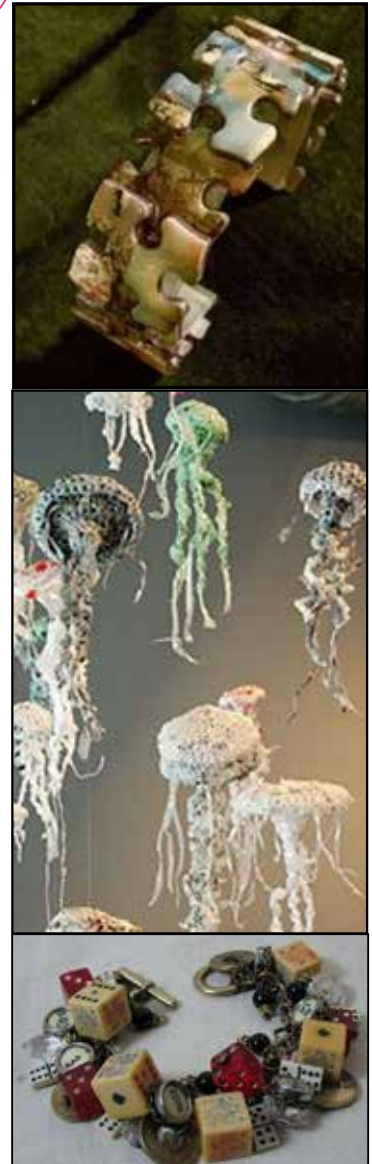
Honolulu Museum of Art School
